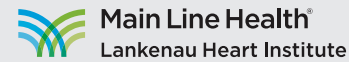

(Implantable cardioverter defibrillator and leads procedures) Provides a national standard on the implant, revision, replacement or explant of ICD/CRT-D to understand treatment patterns, clinical outcomes, device safety and overall quality of care.

IM IMPACT Registry®

(Pediatric and adult congenital treatment procedures) Assesses the prevalence, demographics, management and outcomes of pediatric and adult congenital heart disease patients who undergo diagnostic catheterizations and catheter-based interventions.

L LAAO Registry™

(Left atrial appendage occlusion procedures) Captures data on left atrial appendage occlusion (LAAO) procedures to assess real-world procedural outcomes, short and long-term safety, and comparative effectiveness.

P PVI Registry™

(Lower extremity peripheral vascular interventions, carotid artery revascularization, and endarterectomy procedures) Measures the prevalence, demographics, management and outcomes of patients undergoing lower extremity peripheral arterial catheter-based interventions.

T STS/ACC TVT Registry™

(Transcatheter valve therapy procedures) Monitors real-world outcomes on transcatheter valve therapies leading to improved patient outcomes, enhanced assessment of treatment options and results, and more informed decision making.

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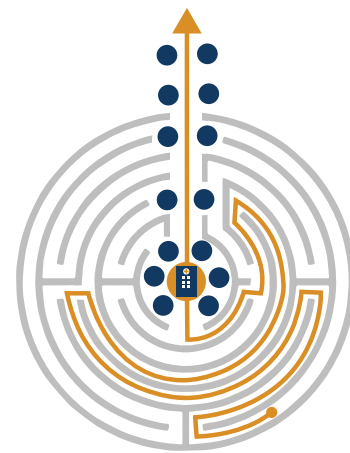

HEART ATTACK

- ▶ Chest pain
- ▶ Difficulty breathing
- ▶ Discomfort in chest, arms, back, neck, shoulder or jaw

STROKE

- ▶ Numbness, weakness or loss of movement in your face, leg or arm, especially on one side
- ▶ Confusion, trouble speaking or understanding
- ▶ Loss of balance

CALL 911

Hospitals have safety measures to protect you from infection.

CALL YOUR DOCTOR if you have a heart condition and have questions or think you need a health visit.
