# ACPC QNet Participation Awards

The ACPC Quality Network Participation Award recognizes participating facilities that are dedicated to collecting data that is crucial to driving quality improvement to advance the development and the delivery of adult congenital heart disease (CHD) and pediatric cardiology standards of care.

## Eligibility Requirements:

1. Submit a minimum of **one metric** for four consecutive quarters (does not have to be the same metric)
2. Attend a minimum of **one of four Learning Sessions** (one member per facility, either live or recorded)
3. Have a **valid contract by March 15** of the year following the award year

# 2022 ACHD Metrics Pilot

- **QNet is looking for volunteers to pilot two sets of ACHD Metrics**, one set of Fontan focused metrics and one set of ToF focused metrics
- Pilot anticipated to run January 10 – February 6, 2022
- Site participation in the pilot will entail:
  1. Forty-five minute pilot kick-off call with all sites to introduce the metrics and answer any initial questions
  2. Submission of written feedback on the metrics after the four-week piloting period
  3. One-hour feedback call to discuss any issues or improvements with the metric authors.
