ABP MOC Requirements for ABP Diplomates:

ABP diplomates are required to earn 100 points in a 5-year cycle in the following categories:

Part II = 40 points • Part IV = 40 points • Remaining 20 in either Part II or Part IV

Earning ABP MOC Part IV credit

To claim credit, physicians must meet the meaningful participation requirements as outlined below for each project:

#	Requirement	Required Action Item
1	Only centers/clinics participating in the ACPC Quality Network are eligible	N/A (As long as your site is enrolled, no other action item is required)
2	Center to confirm collecting/submitting data for BMI or ToF metrics	QNet administrator to email ACC confirming intent to collect metrics
3	Eligible Physician to declare participation on the center's BMI or ToF team (ABP diplomates enrolled in MOC) (please see above timeline for enrollment deadlines)	QNet administrator to email ACC confirming members of team
4	Physician must receive communications through the Quality Network listserv	ACC will add physician to list after QNet admin confirms team member list
5	Participate in design and implementation of change strategies toward the improvement aim	<i>Site responsibility - to be determined by internal site QI team and described on diplomate attestation form</i>
6	Participate in reviewing reports for 2 PDSA cycles (i.e. 2 consecutive quarters/six months)	<i>Site responsibility - to be determined by internal site QI team and described on diplomate attestation form</i>
7	Participate in at least two QI team meetings	<i>Site responsibility - to be determined by internal site QI team and described on diplomate attestation form</i>
8	Complete one QI science training (e.g. the Model for Improvement; PDSA cycles) and tools to assist with data analysis and implementation of this QI project. 9	Complete the BMI or ToF QI project orientation session	Team member must view the full webex recording posted on the QNet website to fulfill this requirement: Available at: http://cvquality.acc.org/en/Initiatives/acpc-quality-network/quality-network-resources.aspx

10	Participate in at least one ACC directed quarterly collaborative QI webinar, ACPC Quality Workgroup meeting addressing the BMI project, OR a specific Learning Session for the project	Participation must be through an ACC directed event. ACC will send out communications about date/time/agenda for QI webinar, workgroup meeting, or learning session. (Note: Participant must participate in at least <u>one</u> of options provided.)
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If a physician has already met his/her MOC requirements and completes another project, the credit will be awarded within the current MOC cycle. The points will not roll over to the next cycle.
