



Patient Appointment Card

A simple patient appointment card is a visual reminder for a patient to remember the specifics of their follow-up visit and key points of their appointment. The card is also an opportunity to remind patients of the importance of their follow-up visit within 7 days and the things they need to bring with them (e.g., medication list). It also reiterates their new medications, any specific instructions, and who to contact if their symptoms worsen.

There are many appointment card styles that can be customized and personalized. They can be stickers, magnets, postcards, etc. Regardless of their format or style, here is a sample template of an appointment card.
